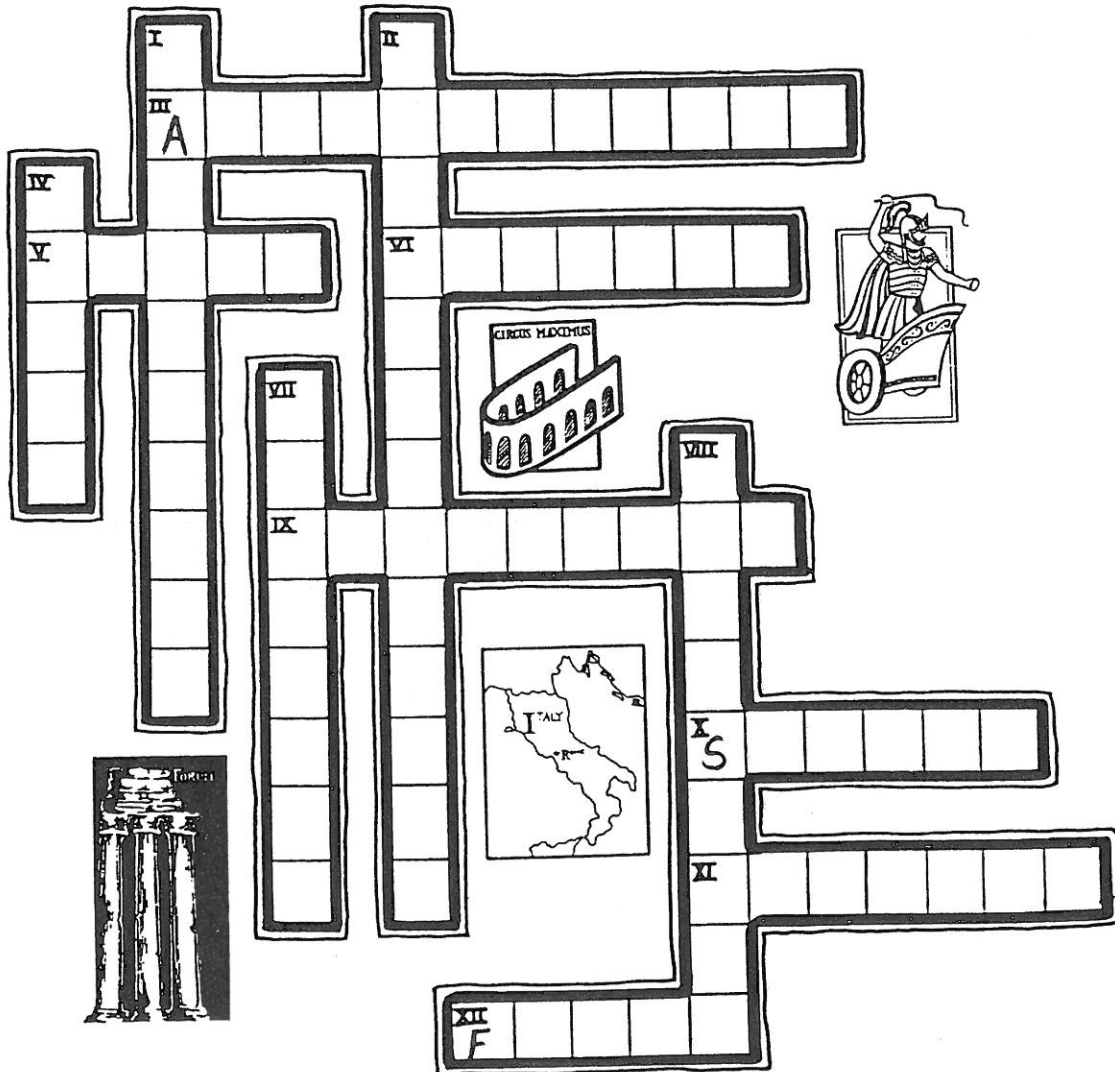


Roman Empire Crossword
